For most of Southern Maryland, Annapolis Planned Parenthood is the nearest clinic offering abortion services. They provide medication abortions up to 10 weeks and in-clinic abortions up to 14 weeks.

Aid Access offers abortion pills by mail for people who cannot access local abortion services. They offer medical consultations online and have information on their website about medication abortions. Due to high demand, they're currently only offering medication to people who are already pregnant, but they hope to resume offering abortion medications to people who can become pregnant, to keep on hand.

Abortion on Demand provides telehealth visits and offers abortion pills by mail, for people up to 8 weeks pregnant, in 22 states including Maryland. They require a physical address to ship to (not a PO Box or UPS box).

Mya Network provides abortion pills (for people up to 10 weeks pregnant) and in-office abortion for people up to 12 weeks pregnant. They offer in-person appointments as well as consultations by phone, email, video, or text, and can mail pills to patients in Maryland.

DCAF provides financial assistance for abortion to patients in DC, Maryland, and Virginia. They work with the DC Abortion Practical Support Network (DAPSN) to provide transport, housing, and escorts to appointments.

When you call, leave a voicemail and a case manager will reach out to you. In your voicemail, include

- your name
- your phone number
- how many weeks pregnant you are
- the date of your doctor's appointment
- whether or not it is okay for them to leave you a voicemail

Baltimore Abortion Fund provides financial assistance and practical support for people getting abortions in Maryland. They work with clinics in Baltimore, Rockville, and Rosedale, and Dupont Clinic in DC. They may also be able to help patients with appointments at other clinics in Maryland.

When you call, leave a voicemail and a case manager will follow up with you. Make sure to include:

- Name
- Phone number where you can be reached
- Whether it's okay to leave a message
- How far along you are in your pregnancy
- Date and location of appointment if you've made one

While they prefer phone, they also take requests for assistance via email if that's more accessible or if calling is an issue for you for whatever reason (safety, cell phone availability, etc.).

Offers pregnancy testing and emergency contraception by appointment, Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays 8:00 am - 11:00 am & 1:00 pm - 3:30 pm. They accept medical assistance and major insurances with out-of-network coverage. Family planning services are offered on a sliding scale based on income.

The Planned Parenthood in Waldorf, MD offers emergency contraception, including the morning-after pill and copper IUD insertion. They can provide birth control pills by mail after an in-person appointment.

As part of our mutual aid and harm reduction efforts, FTP offers over-the-counter meds, including Plan B contraception, at both of our weekly tables. (We also offer canned and dry goods, toiletries, and other essentials.) Everything we offer is no questions asked. The Great Mills table sets up in St. Mary's Square from 11 AM to 1 PM on Sundays, and the Prince Frederick table sets up on West Dares Beach Road (next to the Chipotle) from 11 AM to 1:30 PM on Sundays.

If you can't make it to one of our weekly tables, we can set up a delivery – send a message to our requests page on Facebook.

Take Action

When an illegitimate Supreme Court struck down Roe v. Wade, setting reproductive freedoms, and medical privacy in general, back 50 years, lots of people have been motivated to take action. Everyone brings their own unique skills, talents, and resources, and there are as many ways to get involved in the fight for reproductive justice as there are people.

Ways to act include:

- Volunteer with any of the abortion funds, practical support networks, political groups, or mutual aid networks listed in this brochure.
- Copy and distribute this brochure to make sure everyone in Southern Maryland knows what resources are available to them.
- Donate or fundraise for an abortion fund, practical support network, mutual aid group, or other organization supporting reproductive freedom in the community.
- Contact local, state, and federal legislators and executives and push them to support full reproductive freedom for everyone. In Maryland, this includes refusing to extradite Maryland residents or support out-of-state investigations that criminalize patients who are forced to travel to seek care, and anyone who helps or supports them.
- Share information about medication abortion, including sites like [AidAccess.org](https://aidaccess.org) or [PlanCPills.org](https://plancpills.org).
